




Just a Few Cat Tails...




A Year in Review



As we reflect on this year, we have had our challenges, but also out successes. Here's a look at our year as of November 30, 2021:

- * 65 cats came to JSCR, including cats of all ages
- * 26 cats were adopted into their forever homes
- * We used over 2,100 lbs of wet & dry cat food and over 3,500 lbs of cat litter
- Veterinary expenses are our greatest expense at over \$30,000
